## WINEMAKING NOTES

Small lot, four-day cold soak, puncheon fermentation, extended 14-day maceration. Maintained moderate temperatures during fermentation until dry, then basket pressed.

— 60% new French oak, 20 months

Quintessential Mount Veeder, this Cabernet is rich and powerful, backed by structured, fervent tannins and herbaceous undertones.
