VINEYARD NOTES

Situated on benchland hills, it sees ideal sun exposure during the day and benefits from lingering morning fog and evening coastal winds.

— Loam, Sandstone

WINEMAKING NOTES

Small lot, four-day cold soak and hand punch downs. Maintained moderate temperatures during fermentation until dry, then basket pressed.

— 40% new French and American oak, 18 months

TASTING NOTES

Classic in style, this Cabernet is fresh and savory, backed by fresh acidity, and fine-grained tannins.

— Chocolate Cherry, Plum, Dried Thyme

— Mulberry, Graphite
